
CAKE POP CRUSH DISCUSSION QUESTIONS



Discussion Questions for CAKE POP CRUSH by Suzanne Nelson

- 1. Who is your favorite character in the book and why?
- 2. List three of Ali's strongest personality traits. Now list three of her character flaws. Do the same for Dane. Do you share any of their personality traits? Which ones?
- 3. Compare and contrast Ali's perceptions of Dane from the beginning to the end of the story.
- 4. Think of a time you've lost something or someone special to you. How did it change you? How did you create a legacy for that person or memento?
- 5. Why do you think Ali's father is so resistant to change? Do you agree or disagree with his opinions and why?
- 6. In the story, one of Ali's role models is Renata. Describe an important role model in your own life and how he/she has impacted you.

- 7. Ali is protective of her family. Think of a time when you protected someone you loved. Write a story about it.
- 8. What is Sarah's punishment at the end of the book? How might she have behaved differently? How might it have changed the ending to her part of the story?
- 9. Have you ever participated in a contest or performance where you've had to stand up in front of a large crowd? How did it make you feel? Describe your experience.
- 10. Have you ever experienced a baking disaster of your own? Draw a comic strip illustrating what happened. Have fun!
